

## REPORTED CRIME COMPARISON

UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING (UCR) IS A SYSTEM DEVELOPED AND ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION TO STANDARDIZE AND FACILITATE THE UNIFORM COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS OF CRIME DATA IN THE UNITED STATES. THE PROGRAM PROVIDES A NATIONWIDE VIEW OF CRIME BASED ON THE SUBMISSION OF STATISTICS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

BECAUSE OF THEIR SERIOUSNESS AND FREQUENCY OF OCCURRENCE, SEVEN PART I OFFENSES (CRIMINAL HOMICIDE, FORCIBLE RAPE, ROBBERY, AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, BURGLARY, LARCENY-THEFT, AND MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT) WERE CHOSEN TO COMPRISE A CRIME INDEX AND SERVE AS INDICATORS OF OUR NATION'S CRIME EXPERIENCE.

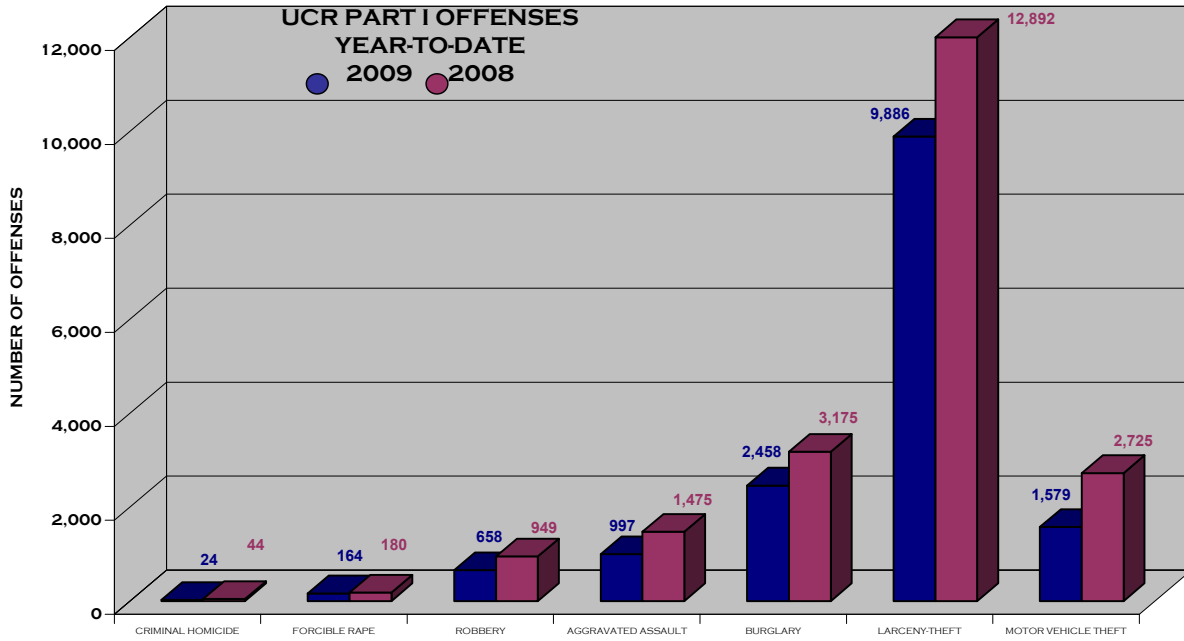

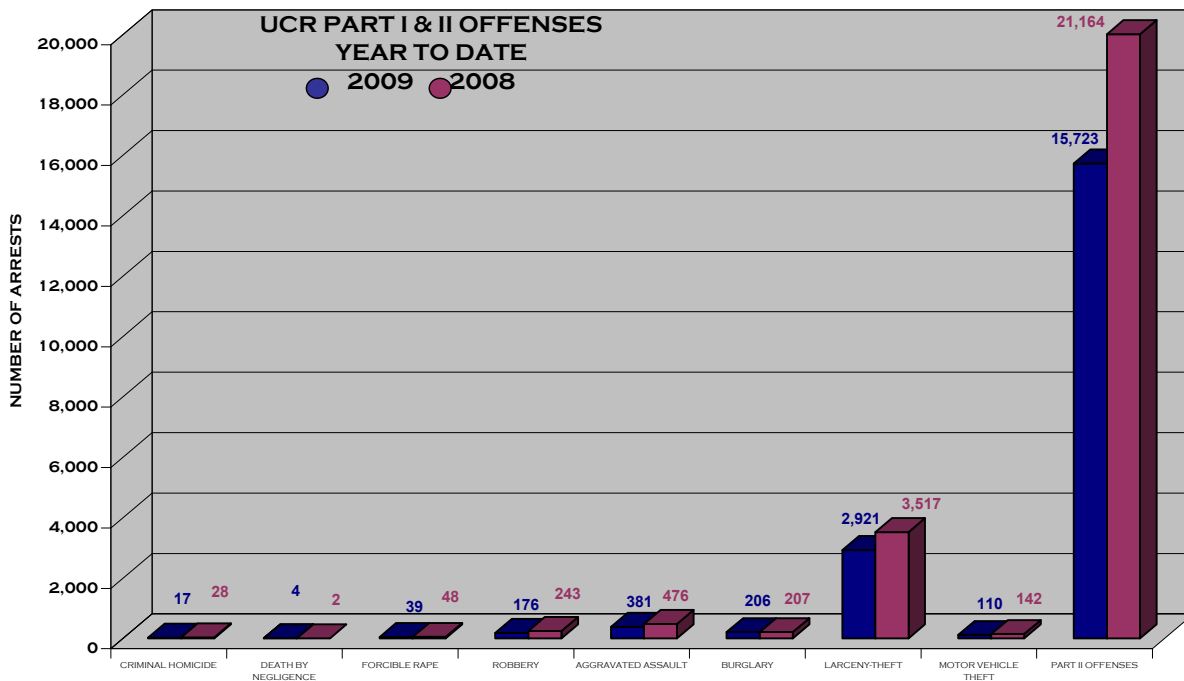

## OFFENSE COMPARISON UCR PART I OFFENSES

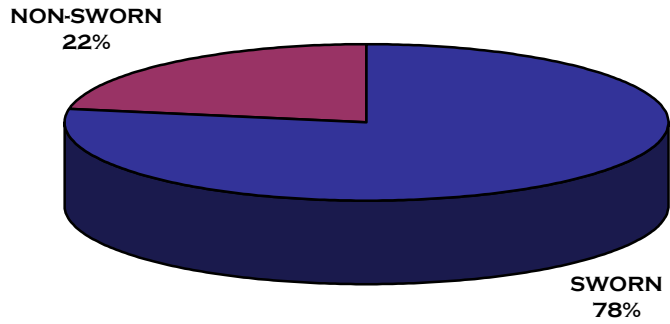


## ARREST COMPARISON UCR PART I AND II OFFENSES

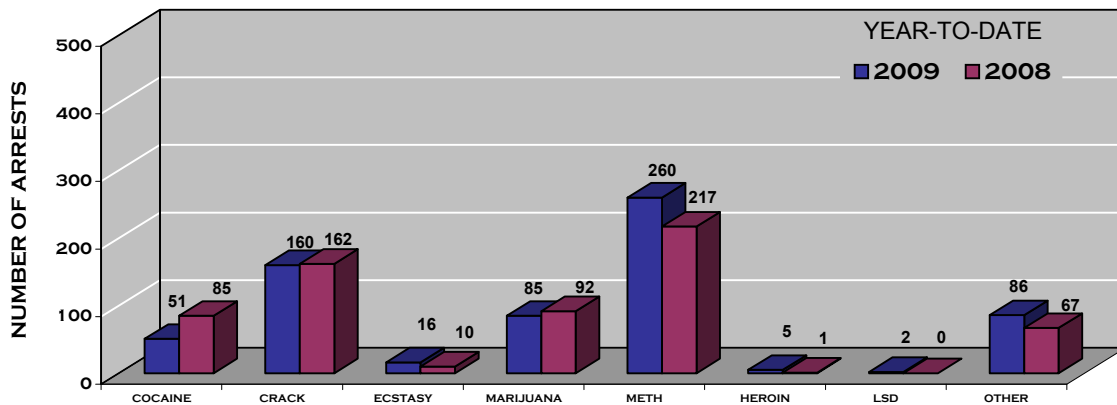

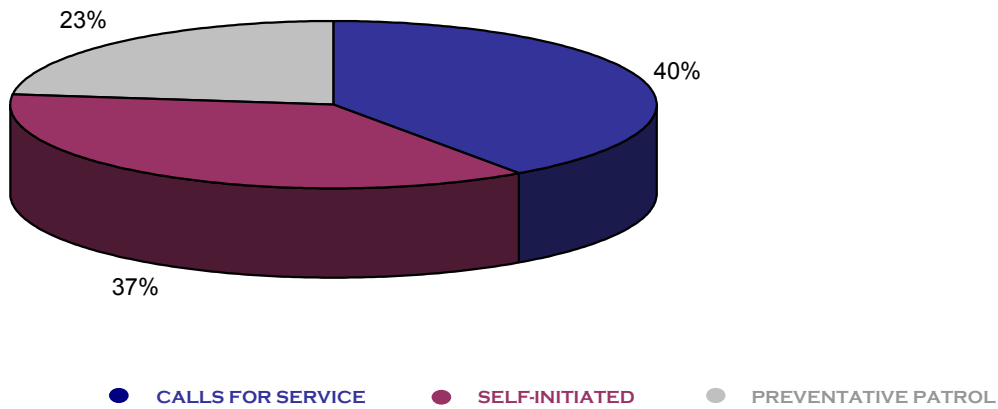

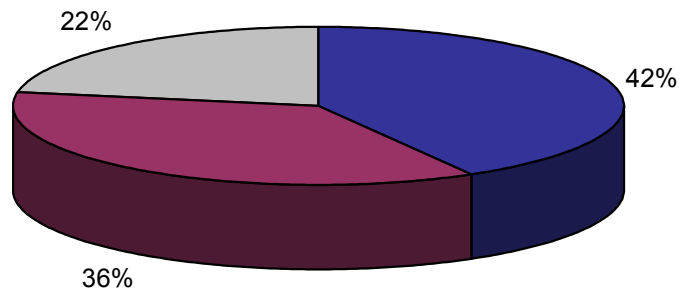
